Dear Ministers and Members,

I am writing on behalf of the parents listed below. We are all families of children attending Whitehorse-area schools including Whitehorse Elementary School, Selkirk Elementary School, Golden Horn Elementary School, Christ the King Elementary School, Holy Family Elementary School, École Emilie Tremblay, Hidden Valley Elementary School and Montessori Borealis Elementary.

Importantly, we are addressing this letter to all parties of the Legislature because we do not want this issue to be treated as partisan. Instead, we are asking all parties to work together to address a vitally important matter relating to the well-being of our children.

We have been watching with increasing alarm the rising number of COVID-19 exposure notices at Yukon's schools over the last number of weeks. As families with at least one child too young to be vaccinated, Friday's announcement by the Acting Chief Medical Officer of Health that there is community spread in Whitehorse has heightened our fears of continued growth in cases within our school system.

The health risks and interruptions to learning that result from these notices are both avoidable and unacceptable. Until vaccinations are approved for the remainder of our school aged population, we must be more proactive in protecting the health of our 11

years and younger students by using every tool available to keep classroom-based learning in place.

To that end, we are requesting the following:

- Immediate implementation of rapid testing protocols at all Yukon schools where the epidemiological conditions suggest testing will help identify and limit COVID-19 infections. This request aligns with actions taken in other jurisdictions, including Alberta and Ontario, to manage COVID-19 caseloads in school populations. Further, we understand Yukon has a stock of rapid tests available for immediate deployment.
- 2. Change the Yukon Communicable Disease Control's directives to require, rather than recommend, self-isolation for any unvaccinated student who is a close contact for COVID-19. We understand there are limitations to enforcement of isolation now that CEMA has been withdrawn, but we trust that parties can work together to come up with a solution that establishes a consistent approach across all Yukon schools on this matter, rather than downloading the responsibility to teachers and administrative staff.

We are in the process of collecting signatures on a petition to be presented to the legislature on the above requests, but hope you will take action on this important matter in advance of our doing so.
