The response is as follows:

Ms. Van Bibber asked for a breakdown of a line item for \$75,000 allotted to the Conrad historic site in the Department of Tourism and Culture's (T&C) 2022-23 budget.

- For the Conrad Historic Site the 2022-23 funding breakdown is as follows:
 - The \$75,000 in question will go towards the conservation of Cabin 1. This year we will have a building conservation expert assist with initial conservation of the cabin. Once completed, Cabin 1 will be used as a seasonal interpretive centre for the site.
 - Conservation of the cabin requires replacing rotten sill logs, bracing the building for reconstruction of a new addition, construction of new windows, doors, a roof and interior flooring.
 - The building conservation expert will work with Historic Sites staff and Carcross/Tagish First Nation (CTFN) citizens or staff to conserve the building while improving log conservation skills.
- The Conrad Historic Sites Operation and Maintenance (O&M) budget this year is \$122,000, which will go towards:
 - Hiring a CTFN citizen for 6 months to assist with implementation of the Heritage Management Plan and the Interpretive Plan (\$52,000);
 - A Transfer Payment Agreement with CTFN to assist with site maintenance (\$20,000);
 - Administration and events - e.g., portable toilet rentals, meetings/events, etc. (\$25,000);
 - Initiative development of interpretive signage at the site (\$25,000).
