The response is as follows:

Answer 1: The Steering Committee is focused on the Placer Mining Act and Quartz Mining Act. This work does not currently include the Miners Lien Act which is a financially-focused Act.

Answer 2: There are 26 registered liens in total. There are currently 12 Yukon entities with registered lien claims. This number includes the Government of Yukon and Yukon Energy Corporation, meaning there are 10 private Yukon businesses in total with liens against Minto Mine. The amount owed to the 10 private Yukon businesses is \$13,751,891; this is equivalent to 32 per cent of the value of all registered lien claims.
