My last question about that corridor is regarding sound barriers between Takhini and the highway and whether there is a look at putting sound barriers there. To clarify the last question, I was talking about in between the Alaska Highway and Takhini North, as the highway is being developed, if there is an opportunity to provide sound barriers for the residents in that area.

Response:

There are no current design plans for the Alaska Highway adjacent to Takhini North. Design of this section may not begin for several years. There are no current plans to look at sound barriers in this location, but that may change in the future, depending on conditions.
