Response:


Greenhouse gas emissions are published by the Government of Yukon every three years with an interim report in between. The latest interim report was published in 2022 with figures current to 2020.

According to the interim report, in 2020 total CO2 emissions for the Government of Yukon building portfolio was 22.18 kilotonnes.

In 2010, total CO2 emissions for the Government of Yukon building portfolio was 18.32 kilotonnes.
