The response is as follows:

On date [MI A]

- There are currently fourty-one (41) outstanding grievances that have been referred to <u>adjudication</u> with the Yukon Public Service Labour Relations Board and the Yukon Teachers Labour Relations Board.
- Of these, fourteen (14) are with the Department of Highways and Public Works; eleven (11) with the Department of Health and Social Services; ten (10) with the Department of Education; three (3) with the Department of Justice; and three (3) are not related to a specific department.
- Additionally, there are currently eight (8) outstanding policy grievances before the Public Service Commissioner.
- The distribution per department of the eight (8) <u>policy</u> grievances is as follows: four (4) from the Department of Education; three (3) from the Department of Health and Social Services; one (1) from the Department of Highway and Public Works.
- One (1) is being investigated and seven (7) are in abeyance by mutual agreement.
- There are currently eight (8) outstanding <u>individual</u> grievances before the Public Service Commissioner, including: four (4) from the Department of Health and Social Services; one (1) from the Department of Highways and Public Works; one (1) from the Department of Justice; one (1) from the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources and one (1) from the Department of Education.
- One (1) individual grievance is scheduled for April, one (1) is to be scheduled and six (6) are in abeyance by mutual agreement. The Yukon government does not comment on the specifics of grievances.
