



**34th Sitting of the Yukon Legislature
Private Members Motions as of 8-Dec 2020**

Wednesdays are reserved for Private Members business in the Legislature, with alternating Wednesdays addressing Opposition and then Government Private Members business.

As of 8-Dec, 2020, 100 motions had been debated with 63 Opposition motions and 37 Government Private Members motions. Of the 63 Opposition motions, 32 were Yukon Party motions and 31 are Yukon NDP motions. Of the 100 motions 79 reached a vote, and 21 were adjourned, meaning the debate did not conclude. Below is a table which shows the breakdown of the motions.

How often have the Yukon Liberals used their majority in voting on motions? Private Members motions have had recorded votes 70 times. Below is a table which outlines the voting record on Private Members motions.

On 8-Dec, 2020 the Leader of the Official Opposition referred to "the government's perfect record of voting against every single motion, amendment, or proposal that either of the opposition parties has proposed." In fact the Government has voted alone on Private Members motions only 14% of the time, and voted unanimously or with other parties 86% of the time.
