Mr. Cathers asked whether there are "...any Yukon government employees who are currently on a paid secondment to another level of government, whether that is the federal government, a First Nation government or a municipality? If so, what is the total amount of wages being paid by the Yukon taxpayers for all of those positions that are effectively supporting the operation of another level of government?

The response is as follows:

Eleven Yukon government staff are on secondment to Yukon First Nation governments or other organizations:

eight placements are being paid for by the host organizations;

two placements are being cost-shared with the host organizations; and

one placement is being paid for by Yukon government.

To uphold employee privacy and confidentiality, we cannot provide the total amount of wages for the three Yukon government staff whose secondments are being fully or partially paid for by Yukon government.
