The following information is an update regarding next steps and estimated timelines for the off-road vehicle regulation.

The public engagement for this proposed regulatory approach closed on April 8, 2019 with an additional open house with stakeholders on April 11, 2019. There was a very high level of participation during the engagement process.

In the coming months, the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources will be compiling all survey and written responses received and will release the results in a What We Heard report. The department estimates the release of this report in late spring or early summer of this year. This report will be available on the EngageYukon.ca website.

The department will use the results of the engagement (including input through meetings, letters, survey results, and workshops) to develop the foundation for the off-road vehicle regulation.
