
**Motion for the Production of Papers No. 19:**

 2019-20 - \$929,529  
 TOTAL: \$1,423,057

(2) Operation and maintenance costs:  
 2019-20 - \$9,804  
 2020-21 - \$15,806

(3) Repair costs for things such as vandalism, are absorbed in the operations and maintenance budget.
