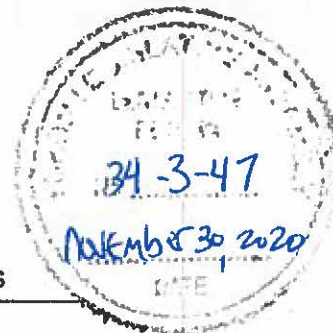

Response:

As part of our Intelligent Transportation System, new digital message boards will be installed at the Carcross cutoff and along the Alaska Highway near the North Klondike turnoff in Whitehorse. The signs are set to be installed this winter and should be fully operational in spring 2021.
