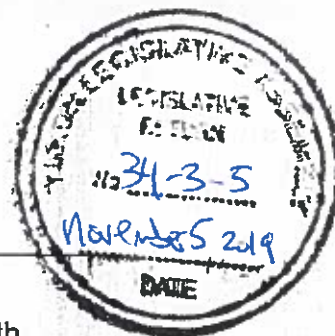

The response is as follows:

On October 31, 2019 the Department of Education was made aware that it had not yet met its commitment to the Legion to distribute the Canada Remembers resources to all Yukon schools.

On November 1, 2019 the resources were hand delivered to all Whitehorse schools except Vanier Catholic Secondary School, Ecole Whitehorse Elementary School, Hidden Valley Elementary School, and Golden Horn Elementary school. On that same day the resources were sent to those four schools, as well as to all rural Yukon schools, by way of priority delivery.

On November 4, 2019 the Deputy Minister of Education spoke to the President of the Legion and apologized on the department's behalf for not having distributed the resources to all Yukon schools within the timeframe that it originally committed to.
