RE: Special Guide Licences

The response is as follows:

This year, 46 special guide licences were issued to Yukon residents. Of these licences, 43 were issued to hunt moose or caribou and, three to hunt bison. The bison season normally ends on March 31.

Each year, the Department of Environment issues a maximum of 100 special guide licences each year for moose or caribou, and 25 for bison.

The other species available to special guide hunters in Yukon include wolf, coyote and black bear. This is as a condition of the license and the hunter must adhere to the non-resident bag limits.

To date, 17 hunters using special guide licences have harvested 13 moose, four caribou, one wolf, and zero bison.
