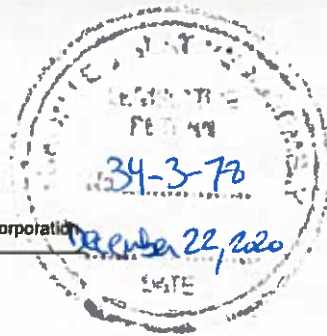

The response is as follows:

The rental diesel costs reported in the October 28, 2020 Legislative Return are based on forecast costs in 2020/21 heating season while costs in Yukon Energy 2021 General Rate Application are based on forecast costs in the 2021 calendar year.

Costs reported in the October 28, 2020 Legislative Return include GST which is not the case in for costs outlined in the 2021 General Rate Application. This reduces the difference to about \$134,000. The residual difference is due to different assumptions for certain unit rates such as mobilization, set up and commissioning.
