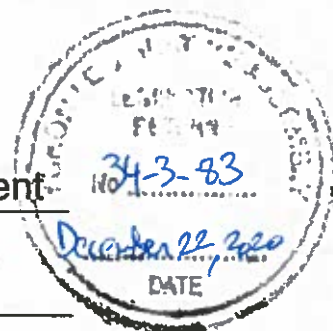

The response is as follows:

Q: "The government announced in August 2019 — at the end of August and then again in September — and signed a letter of intent with the Republic of the Philippines... The letter of intent had been signed by the Minister of Economic Development and the Philippines' Secretary of Labour according to the Yukon government's website on August 28, 2019. But in February 2020, the Philippine government website said that the agreement had not been signed. So, a letter of intent may have been signed, but the agreement had not been signed. Could the minister update this House as to whether or not that agreement with the Government of the Philippines has been signed?"

A: Discussions respecting the Memorandum of Understanding continued following the signing of the letter of intent. The draft Memorandum of Understanding is currently with the Republic of the Philippines for review.
