The response is as follows:

We continued encouraging employees to verify their vaccination status as we approached the November 30, 2021 deadline for vaccination with at least one dose.

Vaccination is the most effective way to limit the transmission of COVID-19 in Yukon schools. We can see right now the positive impacts of vaccination in our secondary schools which have significantly less exposure notices.

By the end of day, on November 30th, 2021, 96% of employees of the Department of Education have completed their attestations.

Most Schools will have minimal impacts to operations from the implementation of the mandatory vaccination requirement. Nonetheless, we are preparing contingency plans for impacts in some schools.
