The response is as follows:

Attestation reporting is not a requirement of non-governmental organizations receiving funding from the Government of Yukon. However, organizations providing services within schools that are non-government have a requirement to be fully vaccinated.

Section 6(1) of the OIC for the Public Health and Safety Act (OIC 2021/151) states that contractors who "attend the employer's [YG] workplace or worksite" require a vaccine (or have an exemption).

Section 1 of the OIC further defines the workplace or worksite as "(b) in the case of the Government of Yukon, a school building that is the property of the Government of Yukon and the school grounds".
