We continue to monitor enrolment and work with our school communities and partners to plan for the long-term needs of delivering French second language programs in Yukon schools. We work with the French Second Language Advisory Committee to plan for French Immersion programming in Yukon schools.

Selkirk Elementary is a “dual track” school that offers both French Immersion and English Programs. At present, the overall demand for French Immersion is being met in the French Immersion programs being offered by those schools and no changes are being contemplated at this time.
