“What will happen regarding testing for the Klondike Road Relay?”

- The 2022 Klondike Road Relay is slated to be back to its original form – starting Sept. 9 in Skagway and ending Sept. 10 at Rotary Peace Park in downtown Whitehorse.
- If COVID-19 restrictions tighten, race organizers at Sport Yukon reserve the right to adjust the course and start the race at the Canadian Border.
- In order for the race to proceed, 700 runners must register by June 5. Registration for the 2022 Race opens May 16.
