If nothing else, legislation should be tabled this fall to empower municipalities in the Yukon (like Whitehorse & Dawson City whose mayors & councils I've been in touch with and have expressed an interest in this) to be able to make their own changes around electoral reform (including lowering the voting age) at the municipal level.
