RE: Yukon government employee numbers

The response is as follows:

As of June 30, 2022, there were 6,390 Yukon government employees. This number accounts for all employees, regardless of how many hours they work or whether they are short-term casuals or auxiliaries who only work as needed to fill in for regular employees. Total employees are counted on a specific day, in contrast to actual full-time equivalents which are calculated for a period of time (such as a quarter or year).

The following table shows the total number of employees by employment type. The total number of employees will not be equal to the sum of counts by employment type as some employees are included in more than one category.
