THAT the Standing Orders of the Yukon Legislative Assembly be amended by  
adding the following new standing order:


"11(3.3) Prior to recognizing a Minister or Cabinet Commissioner on the  
Ministerial Statement, the Speaker must be satisfied that the Government  
House Leader and at least one House Leader of a party in opposition to the  
government are in agreement that the Ministerial Statement should be  
delivered that day."

THAT the Standing Committee on Rules, Elections and Privileges approve by email a  
report with the committee's recommendation regarding ministerial statements.
