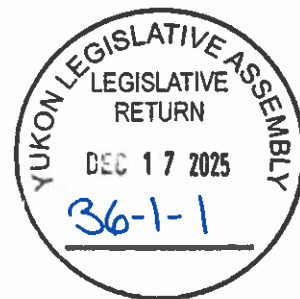

RE: Fiscal management

I have a question for the Minister of Finance. Late last week, provinces and territories got confirmation on the annual funding that they will receive in the form of transfers from the Government of Canada. Can the minister confirm that Yukon's amount is increasing by \$130 million?

The response is as follows:

The Government of Yukon will receive \$1.7 billion in major federal transfers in 2026–27, up from \$1.54 billion in 2025–26. This represents an overall increase of \$129 million year over year.

These transfers include the Canada Health Transfer, Canada Social Transfer, and Territorial Formula Financing (TFF). TFF accounts for the largest share and will rise by \$125 million, from \$1.454 billion in 2025–26 to \$1.579 billion in 2026–27.

An increase in major federal transfers was already anticipated and incorporated into the Yukon's 2025–26 budgeting cycle. The anticipated increase largely reflects the costs to provide government services to a growing population. Therefore, it is important to note that the present \$129 million increase does not represent a brand new, un-budgeted amount.

¹ Canada Health Transfer excludes one-time top-ups to the CHT of \$0.5 million in 2019-20, \$4.4 million in 2020-21, \$2.2 million in 2021-22 and \$2.3 million in 2022-23 to Yukon, but it includes the CHT 5 per cent guarantee top-ups of \$1 million for 2025-26 and of \$2 million for 2026-27.

² TFF includes a transition payment of \$1.3 million for five years starting in 2019-20.
