The response is as follows:

Community Services has the following contracts in place for the:

- management of e-waste with Raven Re-Centre. Raven Re-Centre coordinates the transport as part of that contract, so we are not directly contracting the transport.
- management of tires from municipalities to processors outside of the territory. That contract is with More than Shipping.
- shipping of textiles from periphery sites to Whitehorse with More Than Shipping.
- transport of metals from Yukon government sites to processors outside of the territory with Urban Auto. This is not a yearly contract.

Additional related contracts include:

- Transportation of waste from transfer stations to Whitehorse, which is shared between two contractors, More Than Shipping and General waste.
- CS has a transitional contract with KBL recycling to transport hazardous waste that is not yet included in Extended Producer Responsibility program. This contract does not cover materials that are included in Extended Producer Responsibility programs that are implemented (e.g. waste oil, batteries).

Community Services will continue to work with the Department of Environment and the Producer Responsibility Organization Circular Materials on how contracts are managed in communities. As of Jan 1, 2026, Community Services has no transportation contracts for more Extended Producer Responsibility related commodities (residential paper and packaging products).
