Honouring veterans is a responsibility that reflects Canadians' enduring gratitude for their courage, sacrifice, and unwavering service to our country. We write to support the establishment of an Independent Military Honours Review Board to review cases where evidence indicates that Canadian veterans have met the exceptionally high standard required for the awarding of the Canadian Victoria Cross, our nation's highest military honour for most conspicuous bravery.


Public support for this initiative is substantial, including more than 16,000 signatures on online Petition E-6661 and endorsements from over 110 Canadian organizations. Sustained media coverage further underscores the strong public interest in ensuring extraordinary acts of valour receive appropriate recognition.

Canada's current approach contrasts with that of our Commonwealth partners. Australia and New Zealand have awarded Victoria Crosses since 2001, following the creation of their own versions of the Victoria Cross. Although Canada established its own Victoria Cross in 1993, it has never been awarded.


