Workers paid in the Yukon but taxable in other jurisdictions

- YBS published the 2021 Inter-jurisdictional Employees report in April 2025. The 2022 report is currently in progress and expected to be published by the end of April 2026.
- The most recent tax year for which data are available is 2022. A summary of the data is provided below:


The data presented in the published report for the tax year 2021 are in 2016 constant dollars and therefore differ from the figures shown here.
