The response is as follows:


In 2026-27, the Department of Environment is advancing work on the development of 14 additional sites at the Pine Lake Campground, which is expected to be complete in August 2026.

The Department of Environment has paused implementation work of the following projects in 2026-27:

- A feasibility study to explore adding campsites to the Otter Falls day use area;
- Exploring options for the expansion of Conrad Campground; and
- Contracting work to enhance Tatchun Lake Campground.

Planning work for these projects will continue in 2026-27 to ensure they are positioned for implementation when further capital funding is available in future fiscal years.
