The Department of Environment's Climate Change Secretariat has not had a reduction in full time equivalent positions (FTEs) for 2026-27. The branch continues to have 8.4 FTEs, consistent with staffing levels since 2020, when the Climate Change Secretariat increased the branch's permanent FTEs by 2.8.
