Understanding that the FNRTI is responsible for tracking those, can the minister let me know, out of those 94 calls to action, how many fall to the responsibility of Yukon Government and how many are being implemented?

The response is as follows:

Of the 94 Calls to Action, 34 apply to the Yukon government (YG): 1, 2, 3, 5, 12, 17, 18, 22, 23, 26, 30, 31, 33, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 43, 47, 52, 55, 57, 62, 63, 64, 71, 75, 76, 77, 80, 82, 87, 88.

YG published a public report on the TRC's Calls to Action in October 2023 that provided a narrative and contextual story of implementing the TRC Calls to Action, in partnership with Yukon First Nations governments (attached).

YG annually compiles information provided by departments regarding their efforts to respond to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) Calls to Action. Reporting for 2026 will be undertaken in Spring 2026.
