For the Government of Yukon, the appointment is made by the minister of the respective departments. The appointment is based on a position rather than a name.

Over the years, Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in Government has added one additional Senior Liaison Committee member to help with undertaking the large volume of meetings and work.
