**RE: Civic Addressing for the Mayo Road and Hotsprings Road Areas**

Thank you for the opportunity to discuss civic addressing with you last week. As we discussed, the Department of Community Services has made progress on civic addressing by working with local advisory councils, and is nearing completion of civic addressing within local advisory areas.

I respectfully request your assistance in ensuring that the Mayo Road and Hotsprings Road areas are next on the list for civic addressing.

There are over 900 people living in these two areas, and both are served by the Hootalinqua Volunteer Fire Hall. While neither area has a local advisory council, I am confident that the Hootalinqua Fire Protection Society could work with the Department of Community Services in the same way that local advisory councils have to identify unnamed roads, and to connect with area residents to name those roads.
