Dear Mr. Kent,

I am writing to provide my response to the question you raised in the Legislative Assembly on March 6, 2018 regarding the allocation of Education Assistants by the Department of Education.

The Department of Education uses a needs-based model to allocate Education Assistant staff in a fair and equitable way across Yukon schools. Schools receive an initial allocation each spring. In the fall when the school year has begun, the department adjusts the allocations based on student enrollment and needs at each school.

The final budget allocation target for educational assistants in the schools in the 2017/18 fiscal school year is \$13,945,356, which amounts to 245.407 full-time equivalents (FTEs).

The allocation of these EAs within the Yukon education system as of March 1, 2018, is attached.
