

Dear Premier Silver,

Re: Electoral Reform

Thank you for your letter dated September 30, 2019 indicating that the Chair of the Electoral Reform Commission had resigned and as a result the flawed electoral reform process you began has been put on pause.

It has been noted in local media that the Chair formally resigned on August 29, 2019. We are left wondering why this fact was hidden from the opposition parties and the public for 32 days, and hope that you can provide some answers on that.

I would also like to note that on July 15, 2019 I wrote you a letter outlining our position on electoral reform and reiterating a number of questions surrounding the process you designed to stack the deck in favour of the Liberal Party. I still have not received a response to this letter.

The July 15th letter is in addition to a number of other letters I wrote to you this summer with specific questions about this process. I want to note that you still have not responded to the questions contained in those letters either.

As you know the topic of electoral reform has been discussed in the Yukon Legislative Assembly on a number of occasions. During those discussions the Official Opposition has made very clear its position on the process going forward.

The Official Opposition would be happy to meet with you and the Third Party to have formal discussions surrounding this topic. That said, I will wait until I receive a formal response in writing to my previous letter and questions before we set a meeting time.
