The administrative (non-personnel) cost to run the ATIPP Office is \$30,000 per year.

In 2017/18, ATIPP staff across the Yukon government totalled 13.5 FTEs (full time equivalents). The average expense for the FTEs is approximately \$80K. Broken down by department, they are:
