2. This legislative return relates to a matter outstanding from discussion related to fleet vehicles during the budget general debate, on October 25, 2018 at page(s) 3210 of *Hansard*. The following questions were asked:

1. The fleet vehicle report states that the agency plans on purchasing 51 to 97 vehicles this year. How many of those vehicles have been purchased so far?
2. I guess the last question I would have when the minister is finding out that information is if he could confirm what percentage of the fleet vehicle purchases are purchased locally — if that is possible.

The response is as follows:

1. The Fleet Vehicle Agency planned to acquire approximately 50 to 100 new vehicles in 2018/19 to address departmental needs and to replace old vehicles that have become unsafe or are too costly to operate. A total of 72 vehicles have been procured for the 2018/2019 year.
2. For the past 10 years all Yukon government fleet vehicles have been purchased from Whitehorse businesses.
