2. This legislative return relates to a matter outstanding from discussion related to the budget general debate on October 25, 2018, when the following question was asked at page 3209 of *Hansard*.


Earlier this year, the Minister of Highways and Public Works told us that the government was going to spend nearly \$1 million on the aerodrome in Old Crow. Would the minister be able to provide us with an update on this project? I know they don't like to provide updates and don't like to tell us how things are going, but is the full scope of the project going forward this year, and how much is being spent on that project this year?

The response is as follows:

Below please find an update for Old Crow airport for fiscal year 2018/2019, as requested.

- The capital budget for fiscal year 2018/2019 includes the following expenditures:
 - Purchasing dust suppressant: \$420,000
 - Purchasing and shipping fencing materials: \$142,000
 - Runway resurfacing: \$60,000
- The airport terminal building requires painting. Work was attempted this year, but canceled due to poor weather conditions at the time when the contractor was available. The budget for this work is about \$50,000.
- An additional \$358K was budgeted this year for decommissioning the old refueling facility, but that project has been postponed. More detailed planning and tender preparation activities are needed in order to accommodate the short construction season in Old Crow. This work has now been tentatively rescheduled for fiscal year 2020 in the draft 5-year capital plan.
