With regard to a number of issues raised surrounding the proposed highway improvements at the junction of the Alaska Highway and South Klondike Highway (commonly referred to as the Carcross Cutoff), will the Minister provide an update including:


1. Whether this project is included in this year's budget;
2. Full results of consultation that took place recently on this initiative;
3. Whether this project is subject to a YESAA assessment;
 - a. If so, when will it be submitted?
4. Whether there are measures included for a service road on the west side of the highway near the post office boxes; and
5. What plans are in place for pedestrian crossings.

The answer is as follows:

1. Yes, the project is included in this year's budget.
2. A summary of the consultation is available on the YESAB online registry.
3. The project is currently being assessed by YESAB.
4. No new service road is included in the project.
5. No pedestrian crossing is planned. Based on our assessment, a pedestrian crossing is not warranted.
