The response is as follows:

QUESTION: Can the minister give us an update on the status of the Auditor General's report and recommendations? Have all of the tasks associated with that report been completed?

ANSWER: The Auditor General's January 2009 Report contained thirteen recommendations, eleven of which applied to the Department of Education and two of which applied to Yukon College.

Yukon College has addressed the two recommendations that applied to it.

The Department of Education has addressed nine of the eleven recommendations that applied to it, and continues to refine and improve the measures that it has put in place in this regard (for example, its performance targets and the performance data it collects).

With regard to Recommendation #99 (Long Term Facilities Planning), the department is continuing to work with the Department of Highways and Public Works on comprehensive 'school revitalization' planning to address the future renovation and construction of its school buildings.

With regard to Recommendation #103 (Performance Evaluations of Teaching Staff) the department revised its evaluation process and provided training to its school administrators about the purpose of the evaluation process and the evaluation cycle that must be followed for teaching staff. The department is currently working actively with its education partners on making improvements to the the evaluation process for its teaching staff and school administrators.
