The answer is as follows:

- Each year Yukon gas stations are invited to submit bids for a discounted rate for government purchases of both regular and diesel fuel.
- The purpose of this tender process is to save public funds by asking gas stations for a discount on fill-ups in return for preferential use for government purchases.
- Stations that offer a discount are then itemized on a list and government vehicle operators are asked to use those stations whenever possible.
- Operators may use a station not on the list if the distance to a listed station would offset the discount, or if the discount station is closed.
- Discount agreements are in place with fuel stations in Whitehorse, Teslin, Carmacks, and Beaver Creek.
- The station of choice program is not impacted by the Canada Free Trade Agreement because purchases against the standing offer agreements do not exceed \$25,000.
