This question is regarding infill lot development in my riding of Copperbelt South. In your letter to me dated September 8, 2017 you stated: "At this time the Government of Yukon is not considering transferring land to the City of Whitehorse but would sell identified parcels through a public land lottery..."

1. Can you advise if there is a YESAA assessment that would have to be completed prior to the lottery and sale of these lots by Yukon Government?"

ANSWER:

No, a Yukon Environmental and Socio-economic Assessment Act assessment is not required prior to the lottery and sale by the Yukon government of those lots proposed by the City of Whitehorse for infill development in the Copperbelt South riding. An environmental assessment was conducted at the time of subdivision development. For example, the Whitehorse Copper Development Project was completed in 2004 under the Environmental Assessment Act (EAA).
