Discussions are ongoing regarding Off Road Vehicle (ORV) use in environmentally sensitive areas. Amendments to the Territorial Lands (Yukon) Act in 2013 provided government with the ability to develop regulations to manage ORV use in environmentally sensitive areas. Since then Yukon government held a public consultation and developed a "What We Heard" document. Through that process it is evident this is a complex and multi-faceted issue. Yukon government continues to work with First Nations as well as various stakeholders to identify workable solutions together prior to bringing forward the regulation.
