RE: The Member for Lake Laberge spoke about the members of the Kluane community and how they're asking about the procurement of two bridges on the Aishihik Road, believing that the projects were never listed on a registry. He was asking about that and he was also asking about whether the work procured — how it was procured — and was it a different method from the usual method. At this level of detailed specificity, I would encourage the members opposite to reserve that question for the Minister of Highways and Public Works during departmental debate time. I do not profess to be the pro in this area and my minister will provide those details.

## The response is as follows:

- The Kluane community members are correct that there was no procurement by Highways and Public Works in relation to the installation of the bridges.
- The bridges were purchased in 2016-17 by Highways and Public Works through a public tender.
- The Minister of Highways and Public Works signed a third party agreement with Champagne Aishihik First Nation to install two bridges on the Aishihik Road in 2017-18.
- This work was undertaken on the unmaintained section of the Aishihik Road.
- Champagne Aishihik First Nation was responsible for the proper installation of the structures.
- Champagne Aishihik First Nation retained Castle Rock to install the bridges.
- Castle Rock retained an engineer to oversee the installation of the bridges.
