The response is as follows:

As part of our commitment to reconciliation and long-term capital planning for all Yukon schools, the Government of Yukon is working in partnership with Kluane First Nation to relocate Kluane Lake School from Destruction Bay to Burwash Landing, and to determine the best way to move forward. This move comes at the request of Kluane First Nation.

\$50,000 was allocated for this project in 2018/19, and the full amount was spent on planning work for the school. An additional \$50,000 was allocated in 2019/20 to continue planning work on this project with Kluane First Nation, which has not yet been spent. The amount of money that will be committed to this project in future years has not yet been determined.

This project remains in the Government of Yukon's capital planning process, and we will work with Kluane First Nation and school community partners. We will provide more details on the plan for the school's relocation as they become available.
