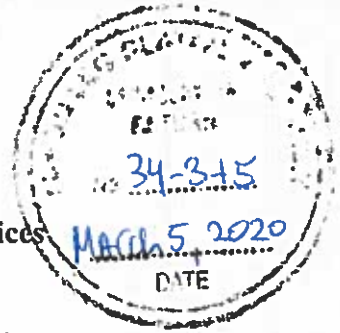

RE: Number of licensed physicians and nurses in Yukon

With respect to the practice of medicine in the territory:

- (1) how many licensed physicians are currently practising medicine in Yukon;
(2) how many licensed physicians are currently providing services at medical clinics in Yukon; and
(3) how many nurses, broken down by facility and community, are currently employed by government and the Yukon Hospital Corporation, including how many are permanent, temporary, and auxiliary on call?

response is as follows:

Please note that the responses provided below are accurate as of the date prepared because the number of physicians and nurses working in Yukon fluctuates over time.

1) Licensed physicians currently practicing medicine in Yukon

Approximately 200 locum, visiting and resident physicians provide services to Yukon residents.

2) Licensed physicians providing services at medical clinics in Yukon

There are 82 resident physicians providing services in medical clinics in Yukon.
