Motion No. _____ RE: changes going forward to the outfitters' quotas as a result of the reduced season at page(s) 2025 of Hansard.

The response is as follows:

No, there will not be any changes going forward to the outfitters' quotas as a result of the reduced season. Wildlife populations in Yukon cannot sustain an increase in harvest if all 2020 unused outfitter harvest quotas were rolled over into 2021.

This year (2020), harvest records show that outfitting clients hunted in 15 outfitting concessions and harvested between 37 to 55 per cent of their normal harvest.

Outfitters currently on quota for moose or caribou may harvest a limited number of animals over their yearly quota, but cannot exceed their maximum allocation for the quota term.

Outfitters need to work with their clients to manage their bookings and harvest allocations.
