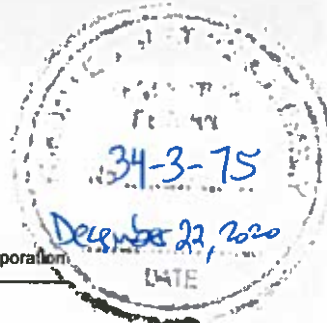

The response is as follows:

Between January 1, 2020 and October 30, 2020, Yukon Energy used the following amounts of thermal fuel for electricity generation.

Liquefied natural gas: approximately 15.1 million litres
Diesel fuel, which includes diesel fuel used for both the rental diesels and the permanent diesel units that Yukon Energy owns, approximately 5 million litres

Information about the litres of LNG and diesel consumed in November and December 2020 are not available at this time.

It should be noted that Yukon Energy used more liquefied natural gas and diesel in the early months of 2020 because of low water levels and inflows into the Aishihik, Marsh Lakes and Mayo reservoirs and cold weather in January 2020.
