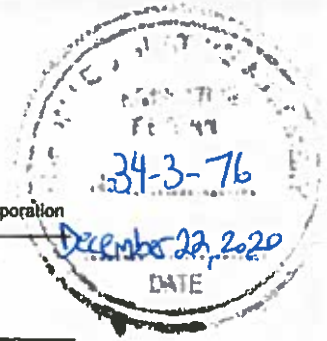

The response is as follows:

Yukon Energy tracks the usage of rental diesel units by the number of hours the units run, not the number of days they do.

Between January 1, 2020 and April 30, 2020, the total number of run-hours registered on the diesel rentals was 4,488 hours.

Please note, multiple units can run at the same time. For example, multiple unit run hours can be recorded during the same hour in any given 24-hour period.
