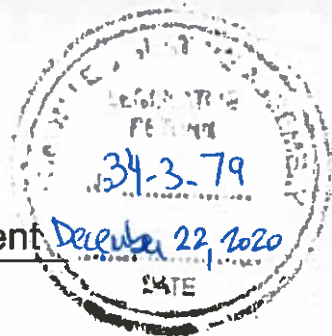


Question: The Government of Yukon had multi-page sponsored content inserted into the Yukon, North of Ordinary magazine recently that provided more details than members of this Legislature have been provided with respect to how Yukon businesses are charting a future during the global epidemic, which is really about the Government of Yukon's contribution. It does provide slightly different data infographics than the minister has provided us in this Legislative Assembly, but I will assume that's just because it's dated.
