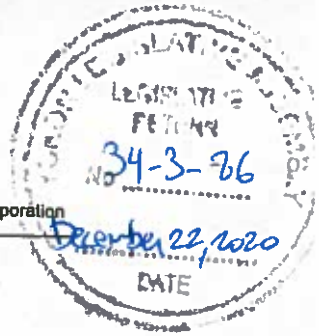

The 17.1 per cent stated in the Yukon Utilities Board Board Order 2020 dash 04 dated December 14, 2020 represents the increase needed in Yukon Energy's 2021 revenue requirement over the 2018 approved revenue requirement.

The 11.5 per cent proposed rate increase that Yukon Energy stated it is seeking in its November 23, 2020 news release is the rate increase needed to obtain that additional revenue requirement.

Higher load forecasts in 2021 reduce the percentage of rate increase needed relative to the percentage increase in revenue requirement needed.
