
The response is as follows:

The Question: Last summer, there was a lot of concern raised by Dawsonites and other Yukoners travelling to and from Dawson about the condition of the north Klondike Highway near Gravel Lake. There has been a large construction project there that has been ongoing for over a year now and has caused damage to vehicles and at times made the road virtually impassable. Can the minister update us on when this work will be completed?

The Response:

Significant improvements are being made to the North Klondike highway. The construction project near Gravel Lake was left in a gravel state over the winter. There is still some work remaining which includes the final grading of the road surface, trimming of the embankment slopes and some ditching work. The Bituminous Surface Treatment will be applied by our maintenance crew during the summer of 2021.
